Acts in an advisory capacity to the GBFEB for the purpose of developing and implementing local coordinated approaches for programs and cooperative activities as outlined in CFR Part 960.107 and set for in the annual work plan.

CFR Authorized Activity	Objective
Community Outreach / Special Drives	Promote and support federally-sponsored in-kind drives across the Region including blood donation; Feds Feed Families and Holiday Toy Drives; Open season health benefits fairs; etc.
Outreach to Veterans	Create and support opportunities to recognize the service of American Veterans; Dissemination of information relating to programs and benefits available for veterans in Federal service;
White House Priorities	Support Presidential initiatives on such things as management reforms; personnel initiatives of the Office of Personnel Management; and programs led by the Office of Management and Budget, and the General Services Administration; Liaison with Schedule C appointees;
Congressional Relations	Establish and Maintain contact with the New England Congressional Delegation on behalf of the GBFEB and the Federal community at-large;
Membership Development	Create and maintain relationships with the more than 190 Federal agency heads in our geographic area; Support 6 FEA's in New England;
Communications	Provide forums for the exchange of information between Washington and the field and among field elements in the metropolitan area about programs and management methods and problems; Develop local coordinated approaches to the development and operation of programs that have common characteristics; Communicate management initiatives and other concerns from Washington to the field to achieve better mutual understanding; .
